This one day conference is designed to facilitate dialogue between Latina leaders and elected officials in Sacramento on public policy affecting Latinas in our the state. HOPE presents up to date information, analysis, and access to decision makers on critical issues impacting Latinas such as access to healthcare, higher education, and the California state budget.

Through hands-on workshops and capitol visits, participants gain a deeper understanding of important community issues, as well as advocacy experience vital to strengthening their civic participation. 2025 marks the 31st Annual Latina Action Day, cementing HOPE's legacy as a leading advocate for Latinas in California.

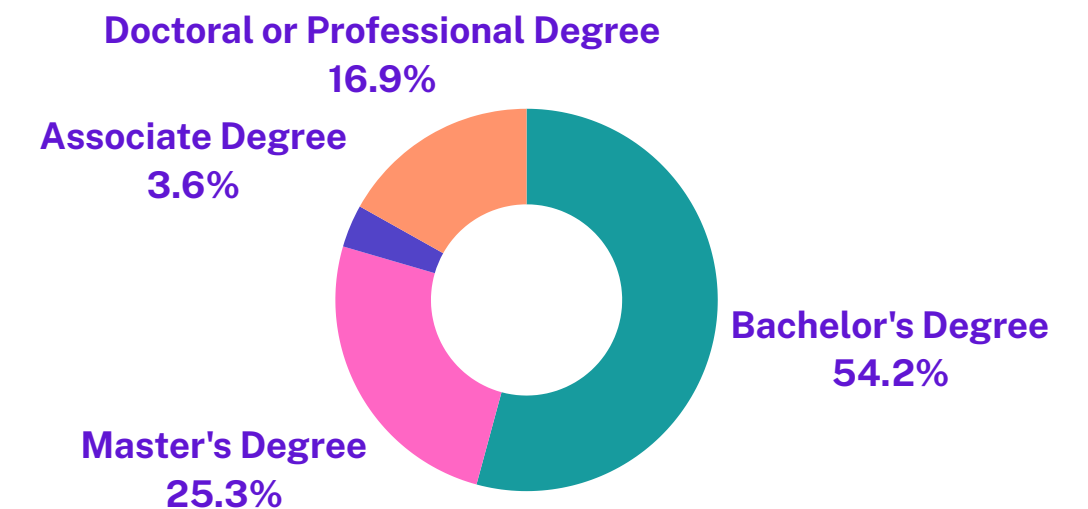

CONFERENCE SESSIONS

At HOPE's Latina Action Day®, participants merge passion with purpose! This extraordinary conference invites individuals to be catalysts for change by actively championing the causes that empower Latinas and their communities. Participants are encouraged to navigate the pressing issues that shape lives and contribute to building a future of political and economic equity.

Latina Action Day® isn't just a conference; it's a dynamic force propelling HOPE's mission forward. By participating, individuals become integral parts of the commitment to ensuring that Latinas have an influential voice in both politics and economics. They seize the opportunity to engage with California's elected officials, gaining the confidence and knowledge to make a lasting impact not only during the conference but far beyond.



GENERAL TRACK SESSIONS

The heartbeat of Latina Action Day is the unwavering call to action. While the specific session topics may change with each passing year, the consistent message resonates powerfully: as Latina leaders, participants play a pivotal role in answering the call to action and shaping a future where equality and opportunity know no bounds.

Previous Sessions include:



COLLEGE AFFORDABILITY AND PATHWAYS TO HIGHER EDUCATION

Latinas are a significant part of California's college-going population, highlighting their growing influence in the state. However, only 58.6% of Latinos were enrolled in college in 2021, and enrollment among recent high school graduates has declined since the pandemic. Dual enrollment, institutional collaboration, and improved financial aid are vital for closing equity gaps, but more action is needed. This session featured key education leaders discussing California's vision to expand college pathways and support its diverse students.



WOMEN'S HEALTH EQUITY: MATERNAL HEALTH IN FOCUS

Persistent health disparities disproportionately affect communities of color, especially in maternal mortality rates. Black women face rates three to four times higher than White women, while Latinas in California also experience elevated rates, which grew by 44% nationwide during the COVID-19 pandemic. This session brought together state health leaders to discuss strategies for eliminating these disparities and ensuring equitable access to safe, dignified healthcare for all.



LEADING WITH HOPE: SUPPORTING LATINA LEADERS FOR A BETTER CALIFORNIA

Latinas are a demographic force in California, making up 39% of the state's women and leading efforts to build a more equitable future, despite limited philanthropic investment. In this session, prominent researchers and Latina leaders shared key data on Latina leadership, personal experiences, and strategies to strengthen the leadership pipeline to benefit all communities.



EQUITY IN MENTAL HEALTH FOR BLACK WOMEN AND LATINAS

Latinx and Black Americans, young people, women, and those with low incomes face the highest risk of mental health challenges, yet current care systems are not designed to meet the needs of Black women and Latinas. This panel featured experts and researchers sharing new data from HOPE and BWOPA-TILE on the mental health of Black and Latina women in California, along with strategies to improve access to care for these communities.

THE YOUTH TRACK

The Latina Action Day® youth session is a platform amplifying the voices of emerging Latina leaders. Here, young leaders seize the opportunity to engage in meaningful discussions, advocating for change on topics close to their hearts – from access to healthcare and education to civic engagement and beyond.

Facilitated by participants of the HOPE Youth Leadership Program, high school students from across California embark on a journey to cultivate a lifelong passion for advocacy. Within the dynamic setting of the Youth Town Hall and Capitol Visits, students not only meet with but also educate and provide valuable recommendations to Senate and Assembly members.
